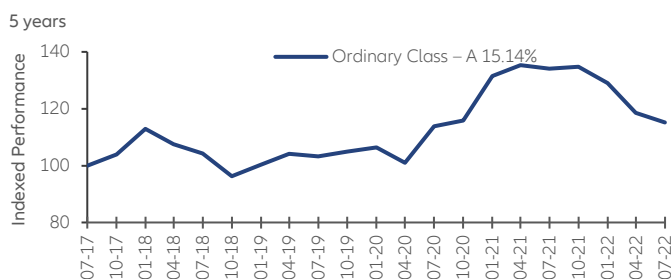

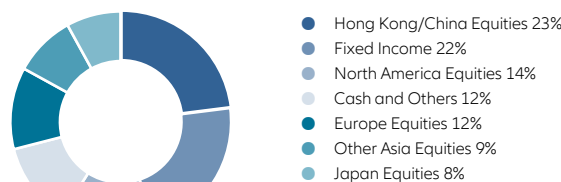

Manager's Comments

US equities surged over July, recording their strongest monthly returns since November 2020. Sentiment was supported by speculation that signs of slowing economic growth would mean the Federal Reserve (Fed) would likely rein in the pace of interest rate hikes later this year. Growth stocks outperformed value shares. Many high-profile tech companies delivered reassuring second-quarter results, indicating they were faring better than many had feared given the backdrop of higher inflation and interest rates. US bonds rebounded over July. While the yield on the 10-year Treasury declined more than 30 basis points over the month, trading back below 2.7%, its lowest level since early-April, the yield on the 2-year note eased only slightly. This caused the yield curve to invert. Such an occurrence is usually regarded to be a strong predictor of a recession. The US economy contracted for the second consecutive quarter, with GDP shrinking by an annualised 0.9% between April and June following a 1.6% annualised contraction in the first quarter.

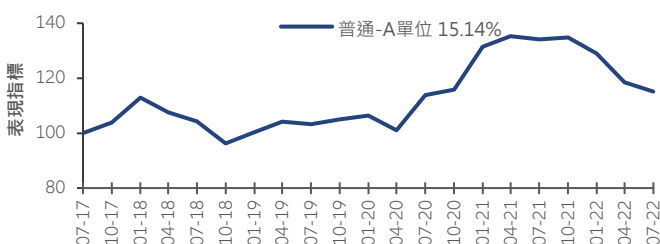

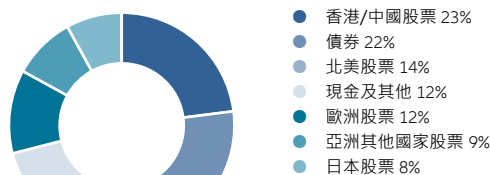

基金經理評論

美國股市在7月份飆升，創下2020年11月以來的最高月度回報。市場揣測經濟增長放緩，意味聯儲局可望於今年稍後時間控制加息步伐，從而為投資情緒帶來支持。增長股表現優於價值股。許多備受矚目的科技公司發表令人欣慰的第二季業績，表明在通脹和利率上升的背景，這些公司的表現相比許多投資者所擔心的情況較好。美國債券在7月份反彈，雖然10年期國庫券收益率在月內下跌超過30個基點，回落至2.7%以下，為4月初以來的最低水平，但2年期國庫券收益率僅略為回落。這導致收益率曲線倒掛。這種情況通常被視為經濟衰退的強烈預測指標。美國經濟連續第二季收縮，國內生產總值繼第一季度度化收縮1.6%後，於4月份至6月份年度化收縮0.9%。
