Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long term capital growth by investing in a portfolio of Hong Kong SAR shares.

Investment strategy

In normal market conditions, the Fund will invest at least 90% of its assets in shares (or securities similar to shares) of companies of any size that are based in, or carry out the larger part of their business activities in, Hong Kong SAR. The Fund can invest up to 20% in China A and China B-shares. For China A-shares, up to 20% through the Shanghai-Hong Kong Stock Connect and/or the Shenzhen-Hong Kong Stock Connect, and up to 10% in CAAPs. The Fund may invest up to 10% in other funds, including HSBC funds. The Fund will not invest more than 10% in Real Estate Investment Trusts. See the Prospectus for a full description of the investment objectives and derivative usage.

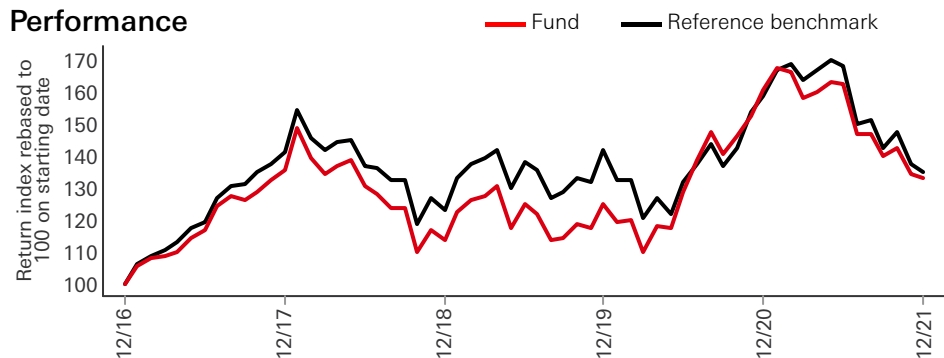

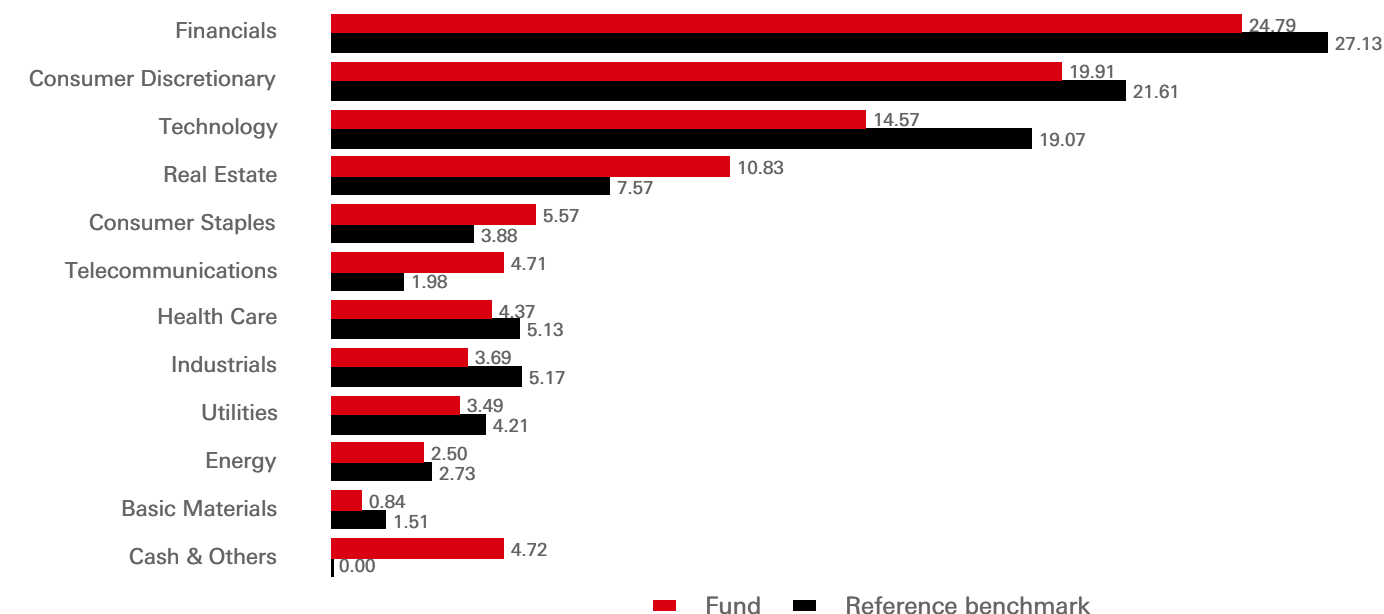

Monthly performance commentary

Stock selection was positive for the month. Positive performance came from Real Estate and Consumer Staples, though this was offset by negative stock selection in Financials and Energy.

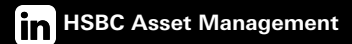
Utilities security, China Resources Power with total effect 0.26% is the top contributor. Additionally, Consumer Staples security, Nongfu Spring was the second largest contributor with total effect 0.15%. Health Care security, BeiGene also contributed with total effect 0.14%.

On the other side, detractors include Financials security HSBC with total effect -0.52%, Health Care holding Wuxi AppTec with total effect -0.29%, and Consumer Discretionary holding BYD with total effect -0.08%.

During this period, positions were initiated in Haier Smart Home and Geely Automobile. Positions were closed in Hysan Development.

Sector allocation effects are residual to stock selection. At the sector level, effects were positive, given an underweight exposure to Technology.

Annually distribution is 1; semi-annually distribution is 2; quarterly distribution is 4; monthly distribution is 12.

The annualised dividend yield is calculated based on the dividend distribution on the relevant date with dividend reinvested, and may be higher or lower than the actual annual dividend yield.
