

Cashless Day Surgery eService – Eligible Surgery List

Exclusively available to selected plans, this service covers day surgery for specialties including Gastroenterology & Hepatology, General Surgery, Orthopedics & Traumatology, Otorhinolaryngology (ENT), Ophthalmology, Dermatology, Obstetrics & Gynaecology and Urology at our preferred medical service providers. Once the application is approved, we will notify customers of the approved credit amount, so they don't need to pay upfront.

The list below sets out the surgeries for which Cashless Day Surgery eService is available. The list will be updated from time to time without prior notice.

If customer does not perform surgery after the first consultation, clinic staff will recover the consultation fee from the customer/ will not provide refund for paid consultation fee.
